

Pasteur Reflection Assignment

Green:

Write or type a two-paragraph essay that includes answers to the following questions. Use the article from class to find information. Your essay must be at least one page long.

Paragraph One – Louis Pasteur Summary

1. In your own words, write a summary of Louis Pasteur life story.
2. What were his major scientific discoveries?
3. How did other scientists treat him?
4. How did he prove himself to be right?

Paragraph Two – About You

1. Tell me about a time when you felt that no one believed you.
2. How did this feel?
3. Were you able to convince them? Why or why not?

Blue and Black:

1. Answer the same questions as above, but decide how many paragraphs are most appropriate after collecting your information and planning what you will write about.
2. Include additional research in your writing. Include a bibliography after your essay that shows where your additional information came from. Within your paragraphs, point out each time you use your extra sources of information by including a citation. Here is an example...
